**Scaling-up of Aid in Mozambique – what is happening? what is needed?**

Government of Mozambique and Donors have established an fruitful partnership for development, based on the commitments towards the principles of the Paris Declaration. The Programme Aid Partnership is considered to be one of the reason for the success of the Country. In Gleneagle (July 2005) it was announced the doubling of Aid by 2010. In 2007 in Maputo the Donor Community was wandering whether a scaling-up of aid would be feasible, profitable and desirable for the beneficiary country. An interesting comparative study of IMF documents on the macroeconomic situation and on the policy advise was lead in order to assess possible scenarios.
